INDEPENDENT LEARNING LEVEL 2

Independent Learning (IL) does not require time in the classroom. Students have to find their own free time to study independently, complete the assigned project, and prepare for the quiz in order to gain the 15%.

Scoring

- 1. IL Quiz 8% (Individual)
- 2. VDO clip 7% (Group project)

Instructions for IL Level 2

1. IL Quiz (8%)

- 1.1. Students have to find their own free time to study all British Council's online resources called 'Learn English.'
 Listen and read the text entirely to learn Story and Vocabulary from each link.
- 1.2. The paper quiz will measure what you have studied from '*Learn English'* provided, so make sure that you study **Vocabulary**, know how to use it, and understand the whole story.
- 1.3. You will have to take the quiz in the classroom, which will be during 28 Oct 1 Nov 2019. Your teacher will announce the quiz guidelines and exact date again. Be prepared for the quiz and try not to miss it.

2. VDO Clip (7%)

- 2.1. This is a group project, so form a group of five students.
 - These links are just examples of each theme, so please DO NOT copy the content to create your video.
 - Choose **one theme** from the 4 themes. <u>For example</u>, if you choose weather theme, you need to find information from other sources and create you video in the form of role-play, interview, song, news report, etc.
 - Every member in each group must participate and appear in the video equally. One student can perform more than one role.
 - Your video should be about 5 minutes long.
 - You have to upload your file on Google Drive or <u>www.youtube.com</u>. Send the URL to your teacher and make sure he or she can watch the video. Your teacher will announce the deadline for submission directly to you in class.
 - If any part of your video is plagiarized, your group will receive a 0. *
 - You have to submit your VDO before 28 Oct 2019. (Your teacher will announce the date again.) **

Your VDO project will be graded according to:


- **1. Completion of the task** (Did you completely finish the task?) 1 points
- 2. Content (Does your video content relate to the theme you've chosen?) 2 points
- 3. Comprehensibility (Do you speak with a clear voice and correct pronunciation?) 3 points
- 4. Fluency (Do you speak and play your role with naturalness?) 2 points
- 5. Creativity (How well does the project represent your group's creativity?) 2 points

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How to study Learn English


- 1. Click on the links provided
